#### End of Year Tax Planning

End of year tax planning from Vanguard's Christine Benz -Owing to changes in the tax laws that went into effect starting in 2018, fewer taxpayers are likely to benefit from itemized deductions than in the past; they'll get a bigger bang from the standard deduction. That calls for rethinking your charitable giving strategy. If you're older than age 70½ and taking required minimum distributions from IRA, you can employ what's called a qualified charitable distribution. With the QCD, you steer all or a portion of your RMD, up to \$100,000, to the charity(ies) of your choice; the amount of your contribution reduces your adjusted gross income. If you're not yet subject to RMDs and/or you'd like to make additional charitable contributions, you can consider "bunching" your charitable contributions into a single year in which you itemize, as discussed. A donor-advised fund enables you to make a large charitable contribution in a given year (and potentially take a deduction on it) but take your time in getting the money deployed to charities.
