History Comes Alive At The United Methodist Church of Lake Ronkonkoma 160th Anniversary Celebration



On Sunday October 28,1956 The Lake Ronkonkoma Methodist Church will celebrate its 160th anniversary. Founded in 1796 as a Methodist Class meeting in the home of Caleb Newton on Lake Ronkonkoma, the Society moved to it's first church building in 1853. This building, now known as the Parish Hall, was rebuilt during last summer. It was lifted from the old stone foundation and a new modern basement area was provided together with a new heating plant and additional washrooms. The interior of the main hall was completely refinished, and new modern lighting installed.

Bishop Frederick D. Newell, the Bishop of the entire New York area of the Methodist Church will reconsecrate the rebuilt Parish Hall at 5 o'clock and after a fellowship supper for the church membership, will address the congregation at the 6:30 Vesper Service commemorating the 160th Anniversary of the foundation of the Church. Dr. Howard J. Cinebell, Pastor of the Great Neck Methodist Church and former Pastor at Lake Ronkonkoma will bring greetings. The District Superintendent, Dr. Asbury G.E. Stromberg will preach at the morning service at 11:00.

As a souvenir of the occasion a special bulletin featuring a picture of the new church will be printed and a new bound directory of the membership, officials and meetings of the church will be distributed.

A number of Methodist ministers from churches in the vicinity will assist in the conduct of the service when the Bishop speaks. Reverend Austin Armistead of Commack, Reverend Gilbert E. Smith of Stony Brook, Reverend Herbery K. Robinson from Patchogue.

Reverend Harold G. Sabin is the present Pastor.
