In order to liquidate this excess inventory, a flea market was established surrounding the church building with the following booths, each manned by a team of volunteers: The Posey Parlor, the Fashion Forum, the Housewares Hut, the Holiday Hideaway, the Knick Knack Knook, the Entertainment Emporium, the Bargain Book Bungalow, and Henhouse Crafts. Each booth did a brisk business, and the event raised in excess of \$2500.00! The Methodist Men grilled up delectable breakfast and lunch fare, and the new bakery across the street, Mayra's, sold an impressive array of boxed cookies. No one left the grounds hungry. And those visitors who were lucky enough to be present from 1:00 to 3:00 enjoyed a concert by the Sunnyland Jazz Trio. "Banjo" Bob Barta, trumpeter Jason Chapman, and oompah specialist, Jeff Furman treated all with two hours of great old standards in Dixieland style.

Sincere thanks go out to everyone who donated time, goods, and effort. Spending the day working together for the good of the church and the community felt especially good after this past year of isolation, frustration, and unease.




