


"Alpha" Program




Seeds of Faith is sharing, educating, and encouraging women's faith journeys.



The Shamrocks are coming!




On March 4th and 11th we will be raising funds to buy children's Bibles for the Easter Bible Buckets we are putting together for the Lighthouse Mission.
