



Dear fellow congregants,

Our Church complex has been open since September 6th and we are trying to return to normal as best we can. Our Sexton continues to clean and disinfect our buildings. Our Nursery School teachers and students have returned. Our Congregation is returning, and so are the special groups that call the United Methodist Church of Lake Ronkonkoma home.

All areas being used are sanitized daily.

The Nursery School donation to the Church has resumed. With the recommencement of some outside meetings in October, the group donations have begun to return. Please, if -at all possible- continue to support your Church by donating as much as you can to offset the shortfall which will be sizeable this year due to the Covid-19 forced closure.

The Trustees have increased our insurance deductible to \$2,500 which will save us close to \$700 in insurance costs this year.

We are currently working on our report for the Charge Conference which is scheduled for November 21 from 2 to 4:30 p.m.

Many challenges have come upon us with the closures and precautions taken during the pandemic. The education programs were halted for about six weeks during the closure when we were all still hoping to re-open and resume our in person instruction. At that point, we began making sure that the Children's message was in the Cyber Service each week. Our wonderful children's choir director, Heather Edwards-Wilson, was also able to continue in cyber rehearsals and prepared her choir to deliver anthems during our online services. Our secondary Sunday school resumed classes on zoom with Alyssa Schoenemann. Our second year Confirmation classes resumed online with their teacher Dennis Subbiondo and we were able to confirm three new members in August. During the spring it was thought to be difficult to ask the elementary children to spend any more time on the computer. Their Sunday school teachers reached out to them by writing letters. Plans were made to start on line instruction in the fall after Tammy Edwards-Wilson, our Sunday School Superintendent, called all of the families involved. They are meeting on zoom on Sundays. Our secondary Sunday school is presently being held on Sunday afternoons via skype from Germany. Alyssa moved there to take a teaching job but continued her commitment to teach her students here in Lake Ronkonkoma. Rich Tom is instructing our second year confirmation class and Diane Hansen will coordinate the program with the goal of receiving them as members when they complete all of their requirements sometime this spring. We will evaluate our efforts in January and decide whether or not it will be safe to invite everyone back to in person learning based on our ability to provide a safe environment and the status of the pandemic in our community. Meanwhile we continue to reach out and invite children to participate in our classes online whenever they can. I am grateful to our steadfast leaders as we try to navigate through these uncertain times. We are committed to leading our youngest to embrace their faith and know that God is there to help them through. We pray that we will make the right decisions that will keep us moving forward as we reach out in new ways to teach our children.
