

"No", the man said. "Actually, I just heard about it and ....."

"All right," said Socrates. "So you don't really know if it's true or not. Now let's try the second filter. The filter of Goodness. Is what you are about to tell me about my student something good?"

"No, on the contrary....."

"So," Socrates continued. "You want to tell me something bad about him, but you're not certain it's true. You may still pass the test though, because there's one filter left: the filter of Usefulness. Is what you want to tell me about my student going to be useful to me?" "No, not really."

"Well," concluded Socrates. "If what you want to tell me is neither true nor good nor even useful, why tell it to me at all?"

This is the reason Socrates was a great philosopher and held in such high esteem.
