

When plans were approved to build the "Little Brown Church", the Official Board decided to auction off the Parish Hall on September 7, 1906, at 2:00 PM. Notices were published in the local newspapers and handbills were posted advertising the sale.
When the day of the auction arrived, only a few people were in attendance. The starting price was \$625 and no one bid higher. Since the auction did not work, the Parish Hall may be seen in present location to this day.




